

**Ramona Bulldog Booster Club
Minutes June 1, 2009**

President Brian Stemm called the meeting to order in the Ramona High School Library at 7:03. *John Hine moved to approve the minutes of the May 4, 2009 meeting as corrected. (attendance chart). The motion was seconded and carried.*

President Brian Stemm reported that the check due for \$2,000 came from the calendar company.

Vice President Kevin Hemphill reported the profits from spring sports snack bar sales as follows: volleyball earned \$328.92, Track \$869.55, Lift-a-Thon \$62.92, softball \$104.92 and RBBC earned \$360.82. Kevin is working on stadium signage and blocking off specific areas of the fence.

Treasurer Karen Vaughan gave the Treasurer's Report in writing. Total Liabilities and Equity for RBBC is **\$86,193.62** as of June 1, 2009. See reverse side of the report for the new check register transaction report. The paperwork has been filled out for permission to hold a raffle at football games. *Kevin Hemphill moved to approve the Treasurer's Report as written. The motion was seconded and carried.*

Brian Stemm gave the Public Relations report. Joan Snelling is going to have Dawg Tag ads by the first week of June, and then we can start printing them. They should be ready to sell right after the fourth of July, and will be valid from August 1, 2009 to July 31, 2010.

John Hine reported RBBC membership has remained at 331. No change from last month.

Brian will order the custom ticket printer that was approved in a previous meeting.

Election of Officers: Kevin Hemphill listed the slate of officers to be voted on:

- Public Relations Chair
- Team Liaison/Membership Chair
- Fundraiser Chair

Kevin nominated Brian Stemm for President.

Debbie Myers nominated herself for the Public Relations position.

Joan Snelling nominated herself (through John Hine) for Team Liaison and Membership.

Mike Adelman nominated himself for the Fundraising Chair.

Kevin Hemphill moved to accept the four nominees as presented. The motion was seconded and carried.

Kevin Hemphill moved to have Julie McAllister fill the secretary's position for one more year. The motion was seconded and carried.

It was noted that the 2009-2010 year will be Brian's last year as President of RBBC.

Fall 2009 Planning and Teams:

Joan is starting to sell season football tickets.

Work on the programs is starting (pictures, ads, etc.) Get pictures of your fall teams to Brian by August 15 for inclusion in the first program, and two weeks prior for all other games.

Kevin reported that he has some volunteers for the snack bar already.

Sponsor Night is Friday, October 2. First Business Bank will foot the bill. Karen Foster is the chairman, and needs a couple more helpers and a down payment for the caterers.

Coaches' Reports:

- Football – 150 signed up for football, and 100 freshmen. The program is not suited to carry that many. The double-header scrimmage CIF “Kickoff Classic” will occur on Aug. 28. There are five scheduled home games.
- Girls Swim placed fourth or fifth (?) at CIF and Boys placed tenth. The Boys had a State Champion diver, broke two school records, and took third in Valley League Championships.
- Track gave kudos to Kevin Hemphill for the snack bar profits. Also kudos to their assistant coaches and helpers. Boys went to CIF with their best core of athletes this year and did very well, placing second. Girls did well in track also.
- ROTC had their Military Ball last Saturday, and are done for the year.
- Baseball lost to Bonita Vista, so their season is over.
- Boys Volleyball had their banquet last Saturday. They were #4 seed in CIF play-offs but didn't go any further. They had a decent season.
